KlimateNet and Climate Action Live partner to build India's next generation climate workforce, starting in Bengaluru

Bengaluru, 3 August 2026

KlimateNet, the global Nature Intelligence Services-As-A-Software, and Climate Action Live, India's climate solutions journalism and careers platform, today announced a strategic partnership to build a new talent pipeline for India's growing climate economy.

The partnership will combine Climate Action Live's growing community of climate professionals, students, employers and readers with KlimateNet's technology for building trusted, verifiable records of climate work. Together, the organisations aim to make it easier for students and professionals to discover climate careers, gain practical experience and demonstrate their capabilities to employers.

The first phase will launch across three Bengaluru campuses, with the goal of engaging 1,000 students. The programme will include campus chapters, climate career bootcamps and opportunities for participants to work on real-world projects addressing Bengaluru's water challenges. Rather than relying solely on resumes or certificates, participants will build portfolios of verified climate work that showcase their skills and contributions.

The partnership also marks the beginning of a long-term collaboration to develop **Career Catalysts**, Climate Action Live's climate careers platform. The platform will connect mission-driven organisations with skilled professionals, students and career changers, while helping users discover jobs, internships, fellowships, mentors, events and learning opportunities across India's climate ecosystem.

The partners will also co-host the **Water in the City Forum** later this month, bringing together students, researchers, civic organisations, startups and industry to explore solutions to Bengaluru's water challenges. Cambridge Institute of Technology, Galactic, Suserra Recyclers and Bengaluru Research & Innovation Network are co-organisers of the event.

"Thousands of talented people want to work on climate but don't know where to begin or how to demonstrate what they can do," said Sandeep Krishnappa, Founder of KlimateNet. "Our partnership with Climate Action

Live creates a pathway where people can gain real-world experience, build trusted evidence of their work and become visible to employers."

"Every week, readers ask us the same question: 'How do I build a career in climate?'" said Madhur Singh, Founder and Editor of Climate Action Live. "Through this partnership, Climate Action Live is moving beyond reporting on the climate economy to helping build its workforce. Career Catalysts will connect talented people with meaningful opportunities and give employers a richer way to discover people who have already demonstrated their commitment and skills."
